

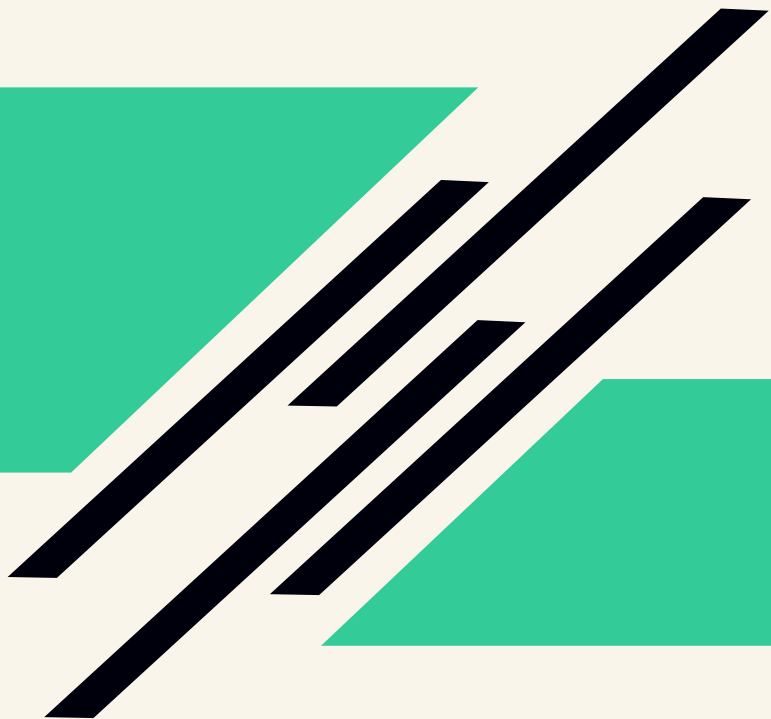

- Length of the paper: 2500-5000 words (The length of the submissions may fall outside the mentioned word limit, if there is worthy cause for it.)

For Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, MFT, Computer Sciences and Psychology:

- Papers should be written in suitable sub-headings like Introduction, Methodology, Result and Discussion, Conclusion etc. Other than full papers, short research communications and reviews are also invited
- Certificate regarding all ethical issues also should be attached
